1. You can ~~both~~ drive or take the train.
Either- bo mamy "or" czyli to lub to.
2. -Are you at home or at work? - ~~None~~. I'm in the car.
Neither- bo mamy do wyboru dwie rzeczy- dom i praca.
3. Nick, John, I need some money. Does ~~some~~ of you have any money I can borrow?
Either- czy któryś z was dwóch
4. He was ~~either~~ handsome nor unattractive. He was average.
Neither- bo mamy "nor" czyli ani przystojny ani nieatrakcyjny
5. ~~Both~~ of my friends has a car.
None- ponieważ jest "has", jeśli chcemy użyć *both* wtedy byłoby *have*
6. Neither my uncle ~~or~~ my aunt could come to my birthday party.
Nor- zamiast "or", ponieważ przy *neither* używamy **NOR**, ale też można zrobić *either + or*, także mamy tutaj dwie możliwości
7. Both us have been to Italy.
Both of us- należy dodać "of"
8. Both my brother and I play football, but ~~either~~ of us play very well.
Neither of us- żaden z nas; *neither* + zaimek osobowy (*us/ them*)
9. I don't want to go to ~~neither~~ of those two pubs. Let's go home.
Either- ponieważ nie możemy użyć *both*, ani *neither* z przeczeniem
10. I watched five films during the festival, but ~~neither~~ of them was good.
None- bo mamy więcej niż dwa.

Task 3- Answers

1. Nikt z nas nie poszedł do pracy dzisiaj.
None of us went to work today.
2. Nikt z nas (dwojga) nie ma samochodu.
Neither of us have a car. (może być też has)
3. Oba te hotele są w porządku.
Both of the hotels/ both hotels are fine.
4. Ani ja ani mój chłopak nie lubimy nudy.
Neither me nor my boyfriend like boredom.
5. Chciałbym mieszkać w Hiszpanii lub Grecji. Oba te kraje są super.
I'd like to live either in Spain or Greece. Both (of the) countries are cool.
6. On jest albo Niemcem albo Holendrem.
He is either German or Dutch.
7. Żaden z moich przyjaciół nie przyjechał mnie odwiedzić.
None of my friends came to visit me.
8. Podobają mi się obie spódnice, ale mogę kupić tylko jedną.
I like both skirts, but I can only buy one of them.
9. Ile książek już przeczytałaś w tym roku? - Żadnej.
How many books have you read so far this year?- None.
10. Żadna z tych dwóch odpowiedzi nie jest poprawna.
